

TIMBER PRODUCTS CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDE

CARE AND MAINTENANCE INFORMATION

Timber doors should only be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth to help preserve the beauty of the wood. Persistent marks can be removed by first using a very mild solution of water and household detergent (non abrasive). Sugar water can be used which is good for removing grease. Once the mark is removed the area should then be wiped over with a soft, damp cloth to remove any excess and then finally dried with a soft, clean cloth.

NOTE: On no account should an abrasive or solvent cleaner be used as they could damage the surface.

Bathroom furniture will be adversely affected by water spillage and heavy condensation. To preserve the condition of your furniture it is very important to wipe dry any excess moisture.

TIMBER PRODUCT SPECIFICATION:

In the production of solid wood and veneered doors, great care is taken in the selection of material. However, being a "living" natural product it is not possible, nor do we feel desirable, to strive for total uniformity of shading and grain pattern. Our aim is at all times to operate with controlled parameters which recognise that some variation is both acceptable and aesthetically pleasing.



Before installing a wooden bathroom into a new property or extension we strongly advise the building is first dry, well ventilated and adequately heated.
