





1200 & 1600 Twin Basin - Double Drawer Wall-Hung Basin



1200 & 1600 Single Basin - Double Drawer Wall-Hung Basin






600 & 800 Double Drawer Wall-Hung Washbasins

600 & 800 Slab - top Basin






