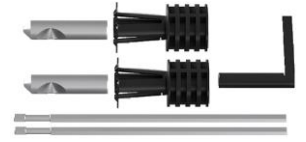


Installation Guide

Corr Wall Hung WC Pan

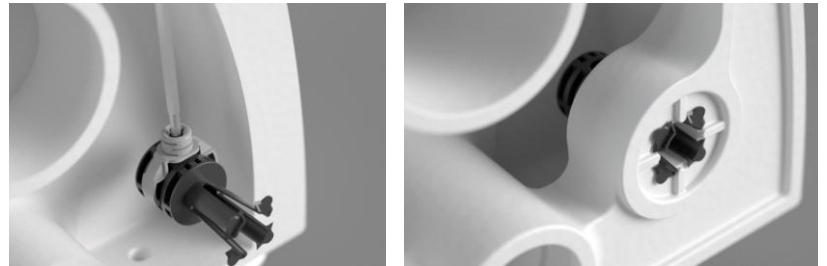
Important Information

- Read the instructions carefully.
- Check the product for any signs of damage.
- It is recommended that a technically competent installer undertakes installation.
- It is the installer's responsibility to carry out a thorough assessment of the wall type and the weight of the cabinet and use appropriate fixings.
- Care should be taken when drilling walls to avoid any hidden wires or pipes.



Installation

Insert the plastic fixings into the holes in the pan from the underside. Ensure that the screw heads face towards the underside of the pan.



Screw the metal fixings onto the threaded rods of your wall frame. Adjust the position on the threaded rods so that the depression in the fixings is pointing downwards and will line-up with the screw head in the plastic fixings.



Offer the pan up to the threaded rods so that the metal fixings enter the plastic fixings inside the pan.

Fit the plastic handle to the long hex key and use this to tighten the hex screws in the plastic fittings. If this pan is being fitted to a tiled wall, it is advisable to apply a bead of silicone between the rear of the pan and the tiles. This is to prevent the tiles cracking as the pan is tightened to the wall.



Ensure that the pan is secure before use.

Seal around the pan using good-quality, sanitary grade silicone sealant.

Care & Maintenance

This pan should be cleaned regularly with warm soapy water. It may then be rinsed with clean water and, if desired, dried and polished with a soft cloth. Regular cleaning will prevent a build-up of soluble salts. Under no circumstances should solvent cleaning agents, bleach or abrasive cleaning agents be used. Do not use cleaning products containing chlorine or acids on the toilet seat. Leave the toilet seat up whenever strong cleaning products are left in the bowl of the pan to prevent damage from vapours.
