Guarantee information

Utopia furniture has been specifically designed and manufactured for performance in general bathroom use and carries a five-year guarantee. All bathroom furniture will deteriorate through prolonged periods of exposure to high levels of condensation and all bathrooms must be adequately ventilated using suitable extraction to avoid this. Failure to ensure adequate ventilation may invalidate your guarantee.

Bathroom furniture is not specified or designed for use in areas of high or regular direct contact with water, particularly in wet room environments or where direct and/or regular water contact is prevalent. Any guarantee does not extend to this use.

Cleaning

- Spills should be removed immediately using a clean cloth.
- Furniture should be regularly dusted with a soft cotton or micro-fibre cloth.
- Occasionally wipe your furniture with a soft cloth dampened with a mild detergent solution. Surfaces should be thoroughly dried with a lint free cloth to prevent water marks.
- Under no circumstances should solvent cleaning agents (such as nitro-based thinners, acetone, nail polish remover or similar products) be used.
- Never use abrasive cleaning agents or cloths (e.g., linen cloths, paper towels etc.) as these will scratch.
- Glass or mirrored panels should be cleaned using a non-solvent-based glass cleaner and a soft cloth.

Bathroom furniture will be adversely affected by water spillage and heavy condensation. To preserve the condition of your furniture it is very important to wipe and dry any excess moisture.

Before installing your timber furniture into a new property or extension we strongly advise the building is first dry, well ventilated, and adequately heated.

Heat

Never place hot objects or heat producing appliances directly onto your furniture. Always use a heat shield, hot pad, or trivet to avoid marking the surface.

Limescale

Bathrooms in harder water areas are susceptible to a build-up of insoluble lime salts. Regular cleaning will minimise this effect.

To remove limescale marks from your furniture, use a solution of 50:50 white vinegar and water. Alternatively, use natural strength lemon juice. Ensure that the vinegar solution is rinsed thoroughly and polished off with a dry cloth.
